    - Audience viewed project-based learning as all or nothing.
    - CCDA "vendor" table - some traffic, not a lot of questions, MACTEC items were not there.
  - Common Core Math Alignment Discussion, Margo Hazelman

- Website is updated with alignments we have finished.
- Margo used state taxonomy to narrow down list of remaining CIP codes and how many are in the state
  - 31 CIPs left, some have less than 3 programs in the state.
    - Suggested that the list of programs be given to CEPD for their input on which are priorities.
  - CEPDs and MACTEC are on board with finishing what we started
- ELA - CEPD want to see an example of what we want to do.
- Need for science alignment
  - All Agri. CIPs to new generation science standards? - Week of July 10, 2-day conference that involved kids. Teachers will be there as chaperones with no agenda. Could use the time to get 10-12 Agr. teachers and science teachers to work on alignment. Crowne Plaza in Lansing.
  - Health CIPs would like science alignment
  - Will these credits be accepted at colleges/universities?
- New Health standards are ready and will be released. Do we want to work on academic alignments to these standards.
