 - MLR - still needs academic alignment done at the state level.
 - Governor's Talent Investment Board (GTIB) - leaders from industry and education to work for clear paths to fill jobs.
 - Michigan is the only state that doesn't oversee Post-Secondary.
 - 61b1 funding – expect changes; new changes have not officially passed.
 - Perkins 5 is actively being discussed. We may have information by the end of the school year.
 - TRAC update
 - Can't TRAC on a cycle (federal)
 - Now based on risk analysis - You can be visited more often or less often
 - OCTE meeting to update risk analysis method in the future
